Our Services

We provide holistic solutions for problems related to the hand and upper extremity.

The hand is an important and complex part of the body. To ensure you get the best possible solution, it is best to consult a specialist, even for conditions or injuries that may seem insignificant.

We combine our expertise in orthopedic, plastic, and microvascular surgery to perform a wide variety of surgical and non-surgical procedures for common and rare conditions. Some of our offerings include:

- Treatment of diseases that affect the upper extremities
- Emergency treatment of minor and major injuries
- Treatment of carpal tunnel syndrome, cubital tunnel syndrome, and other repetitive motion injuries (cumulative trauma)
- Treatment of peripheral nerve compression injuries
- Restoration of hand, arm, and shoulder functions, following disabling injuries
- Reconstruction of birth defects
- Arthritis treatment, including joint reconstruction
- Removal of cysts, tumors, and skin lesions
- Scar removal or revision
- Arthroscopy of the shoulder, elbow, and wrist
- Treatment of Adult Brachial Plexus Injuries
- Treatment of Obstetrical Brachial Plexus Palsy

In addition to providing round-the-clock replantation services (re-attachment of amputated fingers and hands), our institute is actively involved in providing soft tissue cover for open fractures. This service has revolutionized fracture treatment and has vastly improved the results, and in many instances, prevented amputation of the limbs. We pride ourselves on our unique “**Limb Salvage Centre**”

Fellowship Opportunities, Research, and Education

Clinics

We conduct daily out-patient clinics. Fellows will see patients in the clinic with the staff and formulate a treatment plan. The faculty then evaluates the patient and the fellow's treatment plan.

Surgery

Fellows will formulate and discuss the surgical plan in addition to assisting the attending staff in surgery.

Call

Fellows will take the primary call. The clinical call duties of the surgeons at the Dept. of Hand Surgery include 24-hour coverage of Jehangir Hospital.

Teaching

Besides didactic lectures and seminars by the staff, fellows are expected to participate in making formal presentations, as well as journal clubs, and case presentations. First year fellows will be expected to submit at least one scientific paper to a peer-reviewed journal.
